Welcome to AiM, the Achievement in Music! To get started, there are some important dates and procedures you should know about!

Location & Dates:

- Elgin Community College, Building H
- Theory exam: Saturday, **November 23, 2019**
- Performance exam: **Saturday March 14, 2020**
- Honor's Recital: **Sunday March 15, 2020** (location TBD)

Please transfer these dates to your calendar.

Fees

- AiM Theory \$17.00
- AiM Performance \$17.00
- Make-up Exam Fee – levels 1-9 \$17; Levels 10-12 \$36

Enrollment

- Aim Theory enrollment is due **October 23rd**, one month prior to the November AiM exam. (Your teacher enrolls your child.)
- Check with schools and other activities regarding your student's availability on AiM day.
- If there is a conflict, your teacher needs to know **before the time of enrollment** to provide specific information when you can be scheduled.

Exam Hours

- **8:30am – 2:30pm** (students will be scheduled for 15-90 minutes, depending on their level)
- Exam times can be extended before or after the exam times if we know your needs in advance.
- *Scheduling a student on exam day is always preferable over requesting a make-up.*

Make-up

- Make-ups are only accepted when there is no possibility of attending the scheduled AiM day.

- *If you do need to request a make-up, let your teacher know before the time of enrollment.*
- Schedule make-up exam as soon as possible. The exam will be scheduled no more than two weeks after the AiM date.
